PRODUCT 2016 Basket Pressed Grenache

PRODUCER Kay Brothers Amery

COUNTRY South Australia

REGION McLaren Vale

GRAPE VARIETY 98% Grenache

2% Shiraz

ALCOHOL 14.5 % by volume

RESIDUAL SUGAR 0.6 g/l

pH 3.67

WINEMAKING

8.55 tonnes of Grenache grapes were hand harvested on the 10th March. The final ripening period of the 2016 vintage was perfect for Grenache, producing lovely even colour and flavour development in all bunches. Soils are shallow red sandy loam over quartz gravel and ironstone.

Grapes were open fermented and hand plunged for 9 days on skins, prior to traditional Basket pressing. The wine matured a further 8 months in aged French oak puncheons.

DESCRIPTION

Colour: Bright red garnet.

Nose: Pretty aromatic notes of rose petal, raspberries and Turkish delight.

Palate: A densely concentrated wine packed with juicy red fruits, soft velvet tannin and refreshing acidity. Seductive and silky smooth!
